Mrs. Coyle made a motion that the Jefferson County Landmarks Commission accept the easement as presented by Mr. and Mrs. Jonkers with the condition that Mr. Jonkers provide the commission with sufficient photographs which will document the condition of the facade and grounds within Thirty days.

Mr. Theriault seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Mr. Ash announced that Mr. Franzen had requested that he be replaced as a member of the Commission. Capt. Schley replied that he hoped Mr. Frazen could be persuaded to serve since he was familiar with the more than eighty properties having been already designated as landmarks.

The next meeting will be held in the Planner's office January 19, 1989, at $7:00\ \text{PM}$.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
