| Statement of Significance The mill was built prior to 1827 by Benjamin Beeler, who in his 1827 Will noted that the mill was to be kept up for the benefit of his children. Beeler erected the mill as a carding mill to produce cloth. It later became a grist mill and after William Weirick and J. C. Weller purchased it in 1875, a sawmill. It is not known when the mill was razed. The miller's house stands west of the mill wheel and the entire property may be eligible for the National Register under Criterion A for its reflection of patterns of exploration and settlement in Jefferson County. It may also possess significant under Criterion for archaeology, although investigations would have to corroborate that evaluation.
