| This is a painted brick central-passage I-house with a 5-bay facade and centered entry with sidelights. A raised veranda supported by Doric columns extends across the innermost three bays of the facade, accessed by a straight-run stair. Fenestration is flat-topped, with 1/1 sash and shutter hinges. Paired fixed-light sash in the pediments flank the interior gable end brick chimneys. An historic ell extends rearward and a substantial modern addition has been built into the angle of the ell. | | | | | |
