The nearby settlement of Aldrich was originally known as Cameron's Depot and was renamed when the Camerons sold the farm to the Aldriches, who gave the farm its name. The property appears to meet National Register Criterion C for architecture, as early Jefferson County Flemish bond brick farmhouse; an inspection of the interior would be required to confirm this determination.
