This is an early vernacular limestone house with a steeply-pitched laterally-oriented gable roof and interior gable-end stone chimneys. Fenestration is flat-topped with multi-light sash and a hipped-roofed porch extends across the facade. A 1-story gable-roofed section is on the west gable end.

Several dependencies dot the landscape, including a stone smokehouse and a board-and-batten outbuilding set on a raised stone foundation.

Statement of Significance	
This house anchored the Fairfax Stock Farm and is associated with early Quaker heritage in Jefferson County. It appears to meet National Register Criterion C for <i>architecture</i> and A for <i>agriculture</i> , as an early nineteenth-century Jefferson County limestone farmhouse, although an inspection of the interior would be required to confirm this determination.
