<p>This is a handsome 18<sup>th</sup> century five bay residence of limestone with a centered entry and an L-shaped overall plan. Fenestration is flat topped, with multi-light sash, and jack-arch lintels. Interior gable-end stone chimneys.. In the angle of the ell on the rear elevations is a double gallery porch, supported by plain wood posts enclosed with a balustrade with attenuated wood balusters. Statement of Significance	<p>This property is an outstanding local example of the Federal style and is individually listed in the National Register.
