



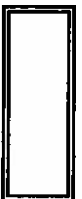

This is a limestone house with a 5-bay facade, laterally-oriented gable roof, and interior gable-end chimneys. The topography makes it appear to be three stories in height, but it is likely of two stories and a raised basement. Fenestration is flat-topped with multi-light, including 9/6, sash. Oversized quoin-like stones define the corners. paired single-hung windows in pediments of gables.
