


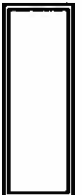

<p>Massing suggests that the house was built in at least two stages, each incorporating a 3-bay centered-entry facade. One of the sections is set back from the other and the entire facade is unified by a 1-story wood veranda with Doric columns, which shields all but the outer two bays. Side gable roof system on both sections. <p>Two dependencies are immediately associated with the subject property. One as a gable-end-oriented central-aisle crib and the other a substantial timber frame barn set on a foundation of limestone, with louvered vents.</p> <p style="text-align: right;"><i>(Use Continuation Sheets)</i></p>	
Statement of Significance	
<p>This property appears eligible for the National Register under Criteria A and C, for <i>exploration and settlement</i>, as a late eighteenth-century Jefferson County rural residence and C for <i>architecture</i>.
