The Jefferson County Landmarks Commission met in the Planning Commission's Office on October the 11th at 10:00 a.m. Those present were Miss Stanley, Mrs. Riely, Dr. Washington, Capt. Schley and Mr. Franzen.

Miss Stanley submitted revised copies of the by-laws and constitution.

Articles I, II, IV and V were discussed and minor modifications were suggested. Paragraphs 4, 6, 8 and 9 of the by-laws were considered next with but few revisions recommended. Miss Stanley will incorporate suggested changes and submit corrected copies at the next meeting.

Road signs were discussed and it was suggested that the Traveler's Rest sign be moved and that the text for the Prato Rio sign be corrected.

An estimate of 15 additional signs were considered for placement near the County's pre-revolutionary homes.

Mames of additional homes to visit were proposed, with October 21st selected as the date for inspection.

Miss Stanley to check whether the Commission's 1974 F.Y. account has been drawn against.

Capt. John Schley's suggestion for ordering 10 new plaques was adopted.
