The Jefferson County Landmarks Commission met at 10:00 A.M. on Monday, March 10th in the offices of the Jefferson County Planning Commission. Those present were Miss Emily Stanley, Mrs. Leeds K. Riely, Dr. John Washington, Capt. John Schley and Mr. Archie Franzen.

Dr. Washington suggested that texts for roadside markers be finalized on standard forms for the purpose and submitted at an early date.

Budgetary matters were next discussed and a bill for \$36.38 for reproduction paper was approved. Capt. Schley submitted the following budget for presentation to the County Court.
