This is a 2-bay vernacular I-house with laterally-oriented gable roof of standing-seam metal and an inferior gable-end brick chimney on the east gable end. A shed-roofed porch extends across the facade and a modern deck has been erected along the west side, wrapping around a portion of the rear. A 2-story shed-roofed addition is on the rear, appearing to date from within the period of significance. Fenestration is flat-topped, 1/1, without notable ornament.
