

This is a large five bay L-shaped limestone residence with a laterally-oriented gable roof and interior gable end chimneys. The main entrance is centered on the facade, suggestive of a central-passage interior plan. The main entrance is presently adorned by a pedimented frontispiece, which does not appear in a 1930's HABS photo of the property. The fenestration is flat-topped, six-over-six, without notable ornament. Extending along the entire facade is a patio supported by stone retaining wall. In the gable ends of the main portion of the house are quarter-round pedimental windows. The ell at the rear of the main house includes several additions of varying years. Dependencies associated with this property include a limestone tenant house beside the main house, with a laterally-oriented gable roof penetrated by gabled dormers. Behind the house, along the creek, is a stone spring house with several additions, and beyond the house associated with the agricultural fields is a series of dependencies including a substantial timber frame wood barn with a silo. This tract was granted to Ralph Wormley by Lord Fairfax. The earliest part of the house was erected c. 1775 by George Wormley. Long-time occupants include Annie Payne Lewis. The property is clearly eligible for the National Register under Criterion C for architecture, as a well-preserved eighteenth-century Jefferson County Georgian house. It was recorded by the Historic American Building Survey in 1937 (WVA-19-MYRTO.V,1), including six photos of the exterior and interior. (Use Continuation Sheets)


